Therapeutic programs for Special Needs and Learning Disabled Students available. For those that want or need to do community service are welcome to help feed, water and care for the horses. Great for preteens and teenagers to keep them active and off the streets helping the horses. Great for all ages, young and old.

We are currently using 10 bales of hay a day to feed the rescued horses. Donations are greatly appreciated.
